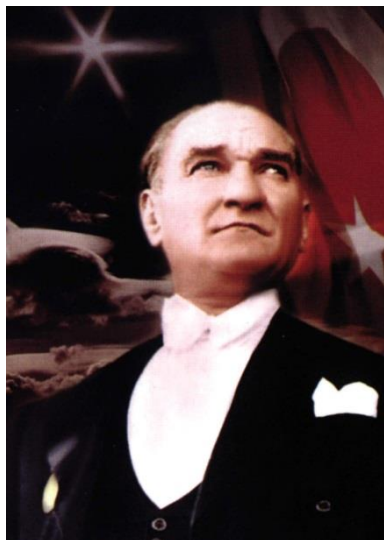
Hi or “Merhaba” in our language!
